

REACH COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

Miri Africa Limited ("Miri Africa") affirms its commitment to the compliance with the EU Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) as amended from time to time.

Miri Africa designs and supplies solar-powered, sensor-based environmental monitoring devices which does not intentionally release chemical substances (listed in Annex XVII of the REACH regulation) from its products under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Accordingly, in line with **Article 7** of the REACH regulation, Miri Africa is not required to register any substances contained in its products.

Based on information provided by its suppliers and manufacturers, and to the best of its knowledge, the products supplied by Miri Africa do not contain **Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs)** in concentrations exceeding 0.1% weight by weight. Where any SVHCs are present below regulatory thresholds, Miri Africa ensures appropriate communication and documentation as required in accordance with **Article 33** of REACH Regulation.

Under **Articles 56 and 67 of the REACH Regulation**, substances listed in Annex XVII and Annex XIV are restricted for use by application or require an authorization prior to use. Miri Africa, to the best of its knowledge and belief, has determined that there are no known Annex XVII restricted substances or Annex XIV substances subject to authorization contained in its product.

Miri Africa works closely with its supply chain to ensure that all components, materials, and substances used in its devices and products comply with applicable REACH obligations, including supplier registration and the provision of relevant safety and compliance information.
